ABOUT BONAIRE

Bonaire is one of three Dutch Caribbean islands, along with the better-known Aruba and Curacao, lying approximately 80km off the coast of Venezuela in the Leeward Antilles. The island is comprised of a wide range of complex natural habitats, from reefs and beaches to deserts and rainforests, all available to explore. Aside from Papiamentu, the island's native language, English, Spanish and Dutch are also spoken on Bonaire.

Consistently rated as the top dive destination in the world and as a pioneer in preserving nature, Bonaire is a dream for every diver. Over 80 dive sites, many of which are easily accessible by shore, truly make Bonaire the shore diving capital of the world.

TRANSPORTATION

Flying into Flamingo International Airport (BON)

You can reach Bonaire directly from the New York area, Houston, Atlanta, and Miami. You can also connect to Bonaire through Aruba or Curaçao.

The Buddy Dive resort is 8 km or 5 miles north of the airport and about 3 km or 2 miles north of the capital town of Kralendijk.

Airport Transfers from Flamingo International Airport are included in your ticket price. Please contact the Dive Buddy Resort to schedule.

Getting Around

A rental truck is included in your ticket price. A valid driving license is needed to drive on the island. People drive on the right-hand side, and on crossings and roundabouts, traffic coming from the right always has the right-of-way, unless road signs state otherwise. Bonaire has no traffic lights, so road signs must be followed.

TRAVEL TIPS

Electricity

On Bonaire the power plug sockets are of type A, B and F. The standard voltage is 127 / 220 V and the frequency is 50 Hz . When living in the USA, you need a power plug adapter. We recommend you to pack a 3 to 2 prong adapter in case type B sockets are not available.

Weather

Lying outside of "Hurricane Alley" to the south, Bonaire offers a consistently warm and sunny climate, averaging around 30°C or 86 °F year-round.
