The Tipsy Turtle Pub is a poolside bar overlooking the beach, specializing in refreshing tropical drinks, and is the gathering place for guests before and after meals. ABOUT CAYMAN BRAC

Cayman Brac is one of the three islands that make up the Cayman Islands, a British Overseas Territory in the Caribbean. It is the second largest island in the territory, located approximately 90 miles (145 kilometers) northeast of Grand Cayman. The island is known for it's lush landscapes, dramatic cliffs, and a slower-paced, tranquil atmosphere compared to its more tourist-heavy neighbor, Grand Cayman.

Diving in Cayman Brac, one of the three Cayman Islands, is an exceptional experience for divers of all levels. Known for its crystal-clear waters, vibrant marine life, and dramatic underwater landscapes, it offers both shallow reefs and deeper walls.

TRANSPORTATION

Arrival Airport: Grand Cayman (GCM)

Getting to Cayman Brac is easy! The most common route is to fly into Grand Cayman (GCM) and take Cayman Airways Express service to Cayman Brac.

Multiple flights from Grand Cayman (GCM) to Cayman Brac (CYB) operate daily. Cayman Airways Express service operates two Saab 340 B+ aircrafts between Grand Cayman and Cayman Brac, and two Twin Otter aircraft between Grand Cayman and Cayman Brac.

When traveling to Cayman Brac via the Twin Otter Service please allow for a minimum of 60 minutes to connect and check-in; Baggage allowance is 55 lbs. per person and only one 15 lbs carry-on. Any excess will be charged \$.50 US per pound.

TRAVEL TIPS

Currency

The official currency of Cayman Brac is the Cayman Islands Dollar (KYD). However, U.S. Dollars (USD) are widely accepted throughout the island. The exchange rate typically hovers around 1 KYD = 1.20 USD, but it can fluctuate.

Electricity

Cayman Brac uses the same electrical system as the United States. The voltage is 120V, and the frequency is 60Hz. The power plugs and sockets are of Type A and Type B, which are the same as those used in the U.S.

Time Difference

Cayman Brac and New York are in the same time zone during Standard Time (both UTC -5).

Weather

Cavman Brac has a tropical climate with warm temperatures year-round. Daytime highs range from 77°F (25°C) in the cooler months (December to February) to 88°F (31°C) in summer. The island experiences moderate rainfall, with the wettest months from May to October and the driest from November to April. While the island is in the hurricane zone, it is less prone to severe storms. Overall, it has a pleasant climate, making it a popular year-round destination.
