The Philippines is an archipelago located in Southeast Asia, consisting of 7,641 islands divided into three main regions: Luzon, Visayas, and Mindanao. It has a population of over 113 million people and its capital is Manila, with Quezon City being the largest city. The official languages are Filipino (based on Tagalog) and English.

From wide angle to macro, Puerto Galera offers numerous sites along its coast, with great diversity. Experience relaxed critter diving (a haven for photographers!) with an abundance of reef fish, to wonderful drift dives, a couple of small wrecks, and a day trip to the incredible Verde Island. Several inner bays offer shallow coral gardens and sandy patches, while the outer bay walls offer incredibly vivid corals, with canyons, swim throughs, rock formations and a couple of small wrecks with heaps of reef fish.

TRANSPORTATION

Arrival Airport:

Ninoy Aquino International Airport (NAIA)

Your ticket price includes round trip transfers between Puerto Galera and Manila. You will be met by a driver at Manila Airport in an air-conditioned van to Batangas. You will then take a fast water taxi between Berberabe and Puerto Galera and finally, a vehicle to the resort (if required, depending on the pier you arrive at).

TRAVEL TIPS

Weather

In October, the Philippines is still in the rainy season, though the intensity of rainfall begins to decrease compared to earlier months. The weather remains warm, with temperatures ranging from 26°C to 32°C (79°F to 90°F), and humidity is still high.

Time

When New York is on Standard Time (EST): The Philippines is 13 hours ahead of New York. When New York is on Daylight Saving Time (EDT): The Philippines is 12 hours ahead of New York.

Electricity

Electricity is provided at a standard voltage of **220V** with a frequency of **60Hz**. The most common plug types are **Type A, B, and C.**

- Divers are required to show a logbook and/or certification card before diving.
- The first dive of the vacation is an "orientation dive" to assess diver's ability and orientate them to procedures and the local area.
